The Millbury School Committee has voted to open seats in grades 9-12 based on enrollment figures, not personal preference.

2. Applications will be accepted until June 30, 2020.
3. Admission is determined by a lottery, on a random basis, if the number of applicants exceeds the number of available seats.
4. Students accepted for admission will be notified. All students accepted for admission will automatically be added to our wait list and should a seat open, we will contact you.
5. Please note that admission to the School Choice program does not include transportation – transportation to and from the school is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. School bus transportation is NOT an option.
6. The wait list for School Choice resets each year so if you were not selected for admission, you will need to apply annually.
