WHAT WE'VE BEEN UP TO

Community Forum

On January 30th the Building Committee held a 2nd Community Forum. An overview of the current school conditions and needs were given and an update on the design options were presented and discussed.

Cost Estimating

The Design Team submitted project information, including drawings, narratives, and project schedules to the cost estimators to estimate each design option.

Design Options

Design options still being explored:

- Option 0 - Base Renovation (Grades 4-6)
- Option A - Addition/Renovation (Grades 4-6)
- Option B - Addition/Renovation (Grades 3-6)
- Option C3 - New 2-Story School (Grades 3-6)
- Option C5 - New 2-Story School (Grades 3-6)



WHAT'S UP IN FEBRUARY?

Review Cost

Estimated costs for all options will be reviewed at the February 6th Building Committee Meeting.

Design Option Matrix

A Matrix was developed by the Leadership Team and the Design Team to guide the District and Building Committee to a preferred design scheme. The matrix is a list of items that are most important to the project. Those items are then rated and tallied. This matrix will be reviewed at the February 6th Building Committee Meeting and a preferred option will be selected.

Submit the Preferred Schematic Report to the MSBA

On February 20th the Design Team will submit the Preferred Schematic Report. This report will summarize the design options and explain why the preferred design option was selected. This submission completes the Feasibility Study and moves the project into Schematic Design.
